BIOGRAPHY

Born in Saint-Tropez in 1969, Corinne Dalle-Ore began painting in her hometown before leaving to study in the United-States where she obtained a scholarship to a university of arts in 1987. Back in Paris, she studied at the Academie Charpentier and the Ateliers de la Grande Chaumiere. In 1991, she changed direction and became involved in music. After working for eight years in the recording industry, she went on a long trip through Asia. It was during this year-long adventure that she produced her first travel sketch books and decided to devote herself fully to painting again. Among her sources of inspiration, in addition to her major influences, Basquiat & Twombly, Dalle Ore readily admits a real affection for the 1950s & 1960s, the old-fashioned aesthetics of the advertising posters of the time, their colour and their specific grain of paper.
