Palma Alvariño is a Spanish artist based in Madrid. Her work is distinguished by a strong energy, where the creative process matters as much as, if not more than the final result. Influenced by American Abstract Expressionism and Spanish Informalism, with references such as Motherwell, Kline, Tàpies, and Chiriac, Palma Alvariño is a Spanish artist based in Madrid. In addition, she has developed a personal style of painting guided by gesture and intuition. Her work seeks beauty in simplicity and authenticity, using pure colors, bold lines, as well as black and raw canvas as essential elements of her visual language. For Alvariño, movement and stability coexist in a constant dialogue: each stroke seems to anticipate another, each curve finds its counterpoint, and the gesture acquires an almost choreographic precision. Within this balance, elegance emerges, and painting becomes a suspended choreography.
