

Kate Brinkworth

Brinkworth's current work began with an interest in films, particularly those directed by or in the style of Hitchcock. She finds the use of camera angles and techniques interesting, specifically the use of 'point-of-view' shots and the varying areas of focus to bring to the attention of the viewer those areas of distinct importance to the scene or plot. Kate Brinkworth started to collect and work from various small objects that she didn't chose for political or ideological reasons, but have undertones from which the viewer may abstract their own opinion. The paintings are not meant to copy a photograph, but to use the language of film and photography to create an image. The image is composed with different degrees of focusing, so that the areas that are blurred automatically become more noticeable for the viewer, it is on purpose that the blurred areas become visually appealing.
