

LA Art Show Celebrates Korean Culture and Exhibitor Highlights...



Exhibitor Highlight: K+Y Contemporary

We're thrilled that K+Y Contemporary will return to the LA Art Show in 2024. Based in Paris and celebrating its 20th year, K+Y Contemporary is dedicated to representing emerging and established contemporary international artists. The gallery's program embraces artworks across all media, including painting, sculpture and photography.

Currently on view at K+Y Contemporary is an exhibition by Catalan artist Lúdia Masllorens. Titled *Face to Face*, the works are large scale originals and lithographs in black acrylic and bleach. The exhibition continues through May 30.
